

CARE & MAINTENANCE - UPHOLSTERY

Regular Cleaning

To maintain upholstery fabric looking at its best and to prolong its life, regular cleaning is essential. Routine cleaning should include regular, light vacuuming to prevent the build up of dust and dirt on the fabrics and the employ of a professional upholstery cleaning service when necessary.

Removing Stains

The best method for avoiding stains, is to clean the area quickly, the longer the spill is left before cleaning, the more difficult it will become to remove. Soak up any excess liquid immediately with a clean piece of paper towel or a clean cloth before they have time to soak into the fabric.

Remove any water based stains by dabbing with a cloth slightly dampened with warm water and if needed an upholstery shampoo. Avoid rubbing the fabric repeatedly as this may lead to damage of the texture and colour.

Any cleaning solutions should be tested in an inconspicuous area before being applied more generally to any fabric.

It is not advised to use bleach-containing agents as they may cause discolouration.

Fabrics should be allowed to dry thoroughly prior to using again.
